

## ACADEMIC LICENSE AGREEMENT

Version 1.1 of May 10, 2005

This Agreement is made between the University of Stuttgart, represented by the  
Institute for Software Technology,  
Universitaetsstr. 38,  
D-70569 Stuttgart, Germany,

("ISTE/PS") and the licensee ("you") shown on Exhibit A entitled "Request for an Academic License". Exhibit A is part of the Agreement and contains the effective date of this Agreement. This license agreement shall be valid only in the presence of an Exhibit A signed by you and ISTE/PS.

Your configuration of the Bauhaus Software contains components distributed to you by ISTE/PS under a license agreement. The copyrights and notices required by the respective licenses are listed in Exhibit B which is also part of this Agreement. Exhibit B may list components that are not part of your specific configuration of the Bauhaus software.

### 1. LICENSE TO USE:

a. For a limited time, ISTE/PS grants you a nonexclusive and non-transferable license to install and use the Bauhaus software in machine-readable object code form only, and any user documentation of the Bauhaus software. Exhibit A may specify restrictions on the number of copies that you may install and use. You may install the Bauhaus software only at sites where you can enforce the restrictions and obligations to which you agree in this license.

b. ISTE/PS grants you the rights specified in paragraph a. above for the **duration of one year** from the effective date of the Agreement. Extensions are possible, if documented in writing.

c. You may make copies of the Bauhaus software solely for internal backup purposes. For your internal use only, you may copy the printed or electronic versions of the user documentation, provided that you reproduce all its proprietary rights notices.

d. You agree not to rent, lease or otherwise make accessible your copies of the Bauhaus software to third parties, modify, create derivative works of, decompile, disassemble, or reverse engineer the Bauhaus software, in whole or in part. You will not allow any other party on your behalf to perform these activities. You agree that any information about the Bauhaus software including, but not limited to, the internal organization, logic, algorithms and processes of the Bauhaus software, shall be deemed to be the confidential and proprietary information of ISTE/PS and its suppliers, which you agree to keep confidential and not to disclose to any third parties, unless said information has been made publicly available by ISTE/PS. Furthermore, you agree not to sell, distribute, assign, sublicense or create derivative works of the documentation without ISTE/PS's written consent.

e. You understand and agree that under this Agreement the use of the Bauhaus software in contexts where ISTE/PS might incur any liability to you or to third parties is expressly forbidden. See the related Sections 5, 6, and 7 of the Agreement.

**f. This academic license is intended for academic research or education purposes only. Under this license, you may not use the Bauhaus software or the results obtained by applying them for any commercial purposes. In projects in which you or your university receive funds from external sources you may use the Bauhaus software only with written permission by ISTE/PS. Granting such permission may involve a fee or a separate licensing agreement.**

**g. This academic license is granted for free.**

2. EXPORT LIMITATIONS: You agree not to transfer, install the Bauhaus software or make it available to persons in violation of German or U.S. export limitations. You agree that you do not intend nor will, directly or indirectly, export or re-export (i) any part of the Bauhaus software, or (ii) any product (or any part thereof), process or service that is the direct product of the Bauhaus software to (a) any country that is subject to German or U.S. export restrictions (currently including, but not necessarily limited to, Iran, Iraq, Syria, Cuba, North Korea, Libya, and Sudan), or to any national of any such country, wherever located, who intends to transmit or transport the products back to such country; (b) to any end-user who you know or have reason to know will utilize them in the design, development or production of nuclear, chemical or biological weapons; or (c) to any end-user who has been prohibited from participating in U.S. export transactions by any federal agency of the U.S. government. You further agree that you will not, without ISTE/PS's written consent, knowingly ship or divert for use the Bauhaus software in any country which has ratified neither the Berne Copyright Convention nor the Universal Copyright Convention.

3. TERRITORIAL OR SITE RESTRICTIONS: Beyond the export limitations of Section 2 above, Exhibit A may specify territorial or site restrictions on your right to install and use the Bauhaus software. You agree to abide by these restrictions.

4. PROPRIETARY RIGHTS: The Bauhaus software is copyrighted. Ownership, intellectual property rights and title in the Bauhaus software is retained by ISTE/PS and its suppliers. The Bauhaus software contains components distributed by ISTE/PS under licensing agreements between ISTE/PS and Third Parties. **You agree that violations of the terms or conditions set forth in this Agreement may subject you to legal prosecution by ISTE/PS or Third Parties whose rights were infringed by your violations.**

5. LIMITED WARRANTY: The Bauhaus software is provided and licensed "as is," without warranty of any kind, and all express or implied conditions, representations and warranties, including but not limited to the implied warranties of merchantability, fitness for a particular purpose and non-infringement, are excluded under this Academic License Agreement.

6. COMPLEX NATURE OF SOFTWARE: The Bauhaus software is highly complex software and includes algorithms producing only approximate results. Some of the analyses address questions that are known to be generally undecidable and hence neither completeness nor complete correctness of the results can be achieved in all cases. Misinterpretation of results by users not aware of premises or limitations of the software as well as errors in the software are possible. ISTE/PS does not represent that the software is free of errors or that all premises and limitations are documented. Therefore, no correctness or other quality guarantees can be given by ISTE/PS. You understand and agree that it is your responsibility to ascertain by independent verification the correctness of the results obtained from the use of the Bauhaus software. Furthermore, you understand and agree that you are responsible for backing up all of your work created in connection with your use of the Bauhaus software. ISTE/PS shall not be liable for loss of data directly or indirectly attributable to the use of the Bauhaus software.

7. LIMITATION OF LIABILITY: To the maximum extent permissible by applicable law, ISTE/PS will not be liable to you or third parties for any damages, including lost revenues, profits, data or other information, or for any special, indirect, incidental, consequential or punitive damages, arising out of the use or misuse of or inability to use the Bauhaus software, even if ISTE/PS has been advised of the possibility of such damages. In any case, liability of ISTE/PS shall be limited to the amount of the license fee paid by you.

Applicable law may disallow some of the exclusions or limitations cited above so that the exclusions or limitations do not apply to you. Under applicable law you may also have additional rights. Under German law, liability of ISTE/PS will be limited to damages caused by gross negligence or intent by ISTE/PS and to damages to life, body, or health of natural persons. See also the related Section 1, paragraph e.

8. MAINTENANCE: You agree that, under this Agreement, ISTE/PS is not obligated to provide any updates of the Bauhaus software or documentation to you. ISTE/PS may, at its sole discretion, provide

you with such updates. You agree that the terms and conditions of this Agreement shall apply to any updates of the Bauhaus software as well.

9. **TERMINATION:** This license terminates after the completion of your research project and no later than the agreed-upon termination date of this license. You may terminate this license Agreement at any time by written notification to ISTE/PS. The license will automatically and immediately terminate, with or without notice from ISTE/PS, if you fail to comply with any term or condition set forth in this Agreement and Exhibit A. Upon termination of the license, you agree to (i) cease the use of the Bauhaus software, (ii) delete all electronic copies of the Bauhaus software and other confidential data made available to you by ISTE/PS, (iii) destroy all physical copies of media containing the software and all copies of the accompanying documentation, and (iv) certify in writing to ISTE/PS that you have taken all of the foregoing actions. Your obligations regarding the confidentiality of certain information, as specified in Section 1, paragraph d., of this Agreement, survive the termination for a period of 10 years.

10. **GOVERNING LAW:** The terms of this license shall be construed in accordance with the laws of Germany. In case of disputes that require adjudication by a court of law, ISTE/PS and you agree to the jurisdiction of the Landgericht Stuttgart, Germany.

11. **WAIVERS:** Any waiver of any provision of this Agreement shall not be effective unless made expressly in writing. Failure of any party to enforce performance of any of the terms of this Agreement shall not be construed as a waiver or relinquishment of any rights or obligations specified in this Agreement.

12. **ENTIRE AGREEMENT:** This Agreement including Exhibits A and B constitutes the entire agreement between ISTE/PS and you with respect to the specific license granted. No modification or amendment to this license shall be valid unless made in writing signed by both parties.

13. **SEVERABILITY:** If any clause or any portion of any clause of this Agreement is held to be invalid by a court of law, the remaining clauses and remaining portions of clauses shall remain in effect. In such an event, the parties shall negotiate in good faith to define a legally valid provision which most closely approximates the original intent of the invalid clause or portion thereof.

14. **FORCE MAJEURE:** Neither party shall be in default if failure to perform any obligation hereunder is caused solely by supervening conditions beyond that party's reasonable control, including without limitation acts of God, civil commotions, strikes, labor disputes, death or serious illness of key personnel, and governmental demands or requirements.
